Brit's work is largely influenced by the theoretical underpinnings of architectural design and the subsequent expressions seen within the discipline. Seeking to capture the essence of ideas through an iterative process, she employs themes of composition, color theory, and materiality while using motifs such as mark-making, layering, and stamping to establish a visual language for conveying conceptual frameworks. She works primarily in acrylic but often infuses other media such as graphite, oil pastels, and ink to emphasize contrasting ideas or details.
